2. One of the summary points of the book of Philippians is that all mature believers should arrive at the same conclusion about our flesh. What is that conclusion?
3. Looking at Philippians 3:3, how did Paul originally put "confidence in the flesh?"
4. Have you had any confidence in your own flesh that you had to lose "for the sake of Christ?" (Verse 7)
5. How do you see your desire for God manifesting in your life?
